- Assistant work center supervisor, successfully entering over 9,632 completed line items into two databases ensuring complete accuracy in shop production output documentation resulting in the reduction of work center backlog by ten percent.
- Managed 41 shop personnel in United States Military Apprenticeship Program (USMAP) induction, tracking and completion, ensuring all weekly, monthly and semi-annual reports were accurately accounted for and entered to provide Sailors with a civilian equivalent journeyman's certificate.
- Supervised a team of thirteen personnel and oversaw five additional team leaders during the calibration lab's Six Sigma Lean event, amassing over 70 hours and accomplishing over 30 tasks, including the redistribution of the shop's materials effectively increasing production.
